The 19th IHIWS organising committee is pleased to announce **Travel Awards for early-career scientists**, designed to support attendance and participation from a global community.

Award Details

- **Number of Awards:** Five young scientists will be selected.
- **Award Amount:** €2,000 per awardee.
- **Eligible Expenses:** Registration fees, travel and local transportation, and accommodation during the workshop.

Eligibility Criteria

- Candidates should:
- Be a PhD student or have completed their PhD after **June 1, 2021**.
- Be actively involved in one or more workshop-related projects (project name(s) must be included in the application).
- Submit a **support letter from their mentor or supervisor**.
- Provide proof of registration before funds are disbursed if selected.



Key Deadline

Applications must be submitted **before January 15, 2026**, via the designated application form. All applicants will receive notification of the decision by **March 1, 2026**.
